TRUST AND RELATIONSHIP ACCOUNTING


Here are some things to think about when implementing an agreement. In business and personal relationships, there is a form of "personal contracting." Key elements of this contract are trust, the state of the relationship itself, or the "relationship account," and our personal accountability for commitments.

Trust

My Trust of You


- Your perception of my sincerity

TRUST AND RELATIONSHIP ACCOUNTING

What are some positive actions, or "deposits", that you have made and/or could make that would leave the relationship account in a positive balance?
